DJ Trainee Overview

In order to be certified as a programmer, and have a new program approved, the trainee must:

- -Be familiar with the Main Mixer & understand its function.
- -Understand DJ equipment including DJ Mixer, CD Players & computer/software (turntables & cassette deck if needed).
- -Must have a good understanding of how to troubleshoot any equipment problems that may arise.
- -Know the required elements for a program (Station lds, Announcements, etc)
- -Create a thirty-minute demo for the programming committee that demonstrates an understanding of the equipment & required elements of a program.
- -Written test based on KBRP Handbooks & practical test in studio.
